



How to Register for the DNE Reimbursement Portal

OVERVIEW

This guide provides step-by-step instructions for registering your business in the DNE Midstream Incentive Portal. The individual who completes the initial registration will be designated as the primary account administrator. We recommend that this role be assigned to the business owner or a member of senior management. After the account has been established, the primary administrator can add additional users to access the portal and submit incentive claims on the company's behalf.

Note:

For the **PSE&G Residential** and **RECO Residential** programs, you will use the DNE portal **only to register for payments**. All claims for these programs must be submitted directly through the utility's portal.

For **all other programs**, you will use the **DNE Portal** to submit your claims.

Step One: Go to [DNE's website](#) and select "Register"

PAYMENT PORTAL REGISTRATION

If you participate in the **PSE&G Residential** or **Rockland Electric Company (RECO) Residential Rebate Program**, you must submit your rebate applications directly to the utility program in accordance with its submission requirements.

To receive your rebate payment, you are also required to register in **DNE's Payment Portal**. All rebate payments are issued via ACH to the bank account you provide during registration and are typically remitted within 7–10 business days of DNE receiving payment from the utility program.

This Program Participation Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of 17th day of June, 2026 ("Effective Date") by and between test dne account egia ("Dealer") and Daikin Northeast (DNE) in connection with participation in the DNE / PSE&G Commercial & Industrial Midstream Program ("Program"). Electric & Gas Industries Association ("EGIA"), on behalf of DNE, administers the Program. The Program is implemented by DNV Energy Systems ("Implementer") and offered in coordination with PSE&G. EGIA is responsible for application processing, eligibility validation, documentation tracking, and incentive payment distribution.

1.0 DEFINITIONS

For purposes of this Agreement, Dealer refers to a licensed contractor or installer purchasing qualifying equipment from DNE and installing it at an eligible commercial site. Program Incentive refers to financial incentives subject to change at any time at the sole discretion of the program or utility, and funding availability. Participating Utility refers to PSE&G. Qualifying Equipment refers to products listed on the Program's Qualified Products List (QPL).

2.0 Project Eligibility

To qualify for incentives, equipment must be purchased through DNE and installed at a commercial site with an active non-residential electric and/or gas account, depending

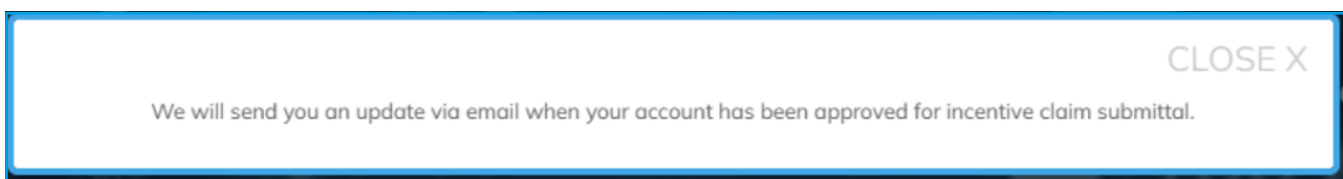
